

NAAHA 2010 HIGH POINT RULES

The High Point Program is open to all NAAHA members and registered Anglo-Arabian horses. The goal of this awards program is to promote greater competitive participation and patronage, as well as recognize and honor the Anglo-Arabian horse.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT - All horses must be entered by a NAAHA member. You must enter and pay for each division that you would like to participate in. A copy of registration papers for horses entered must be included. Please complete ALL information requested on the Registration Form

ENTRY FEE DEADLINE - The postmark deadline is July 1, 2010 with a \$10.00 entry fee per horse per division. Late entry fee is \$20.00 per horse per division until October 1, 2010. No entry after October 1, 2010.

SHOW/EVENT VERIFICATION - A Secretary's signature IS NOT required, but the following information must be provided on the tally point sheet and sent to the NAAHA: SHOW/EVENT NAME, DATE, RATING, CLASS, PLACING, SECRETARY'S NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER. Please do not send tally point sheets without this information. NO POINTS WILL BE GIVEN FOR EVENTS THAT ARE MISSING INFORMATION FROM YOUR TALLY POINT SHEET. Sorry, we will not call you to obtain missing information.

TALLY POINT SHEET DEADLINE -It is requested tally point sheets be sent to the NAAHA on a monthly basis. Please feel free to send tally sheets by e-mail or postal mail. The deadline for ALL tally point sheets must be postmarked by November 1, 2010. Show/rides during the last 30 plus day period, prior to December 1st, will be the exception as long as you notify NAAHA of your intentions and call in or e-mail the results asap. The absolute cut off date for counting shows is December 1, 2010. Any show(s) you participate in after that time can be used for the next year.
